**Venue:** Montego Bay, Jamaica

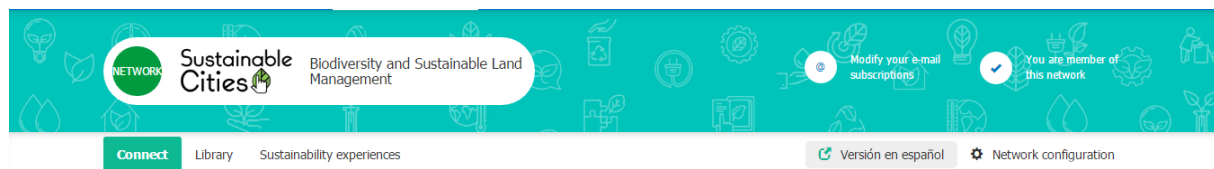
### Course Objective:

**All participants of Sustainable Cities Course** are invited to be a part of our network, share their regional projects and experiences, and meet other members with similar interests.

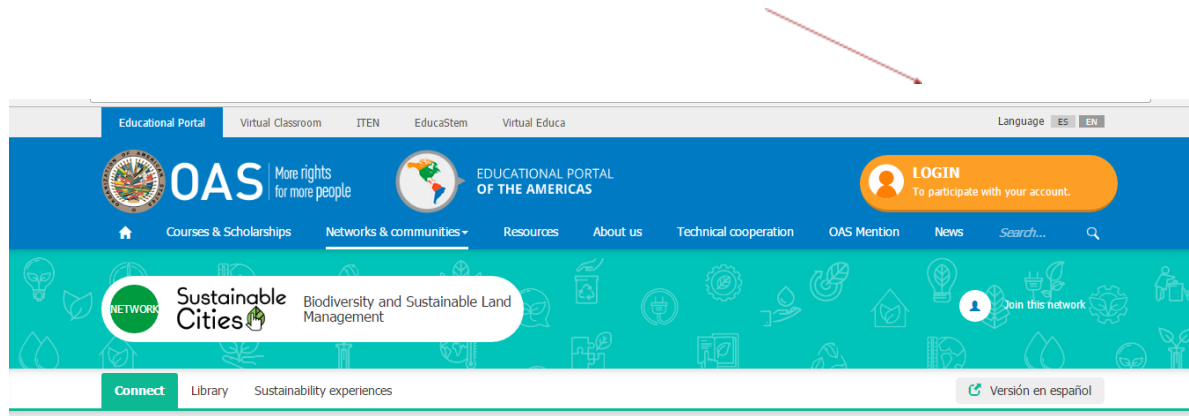
For this edition of our course, we have created a special section in the Virtual Network. This space is designed to share knowledge and discuss the subjects of the course.

This is a step by step guide for logging into the virtual community and to publish information.

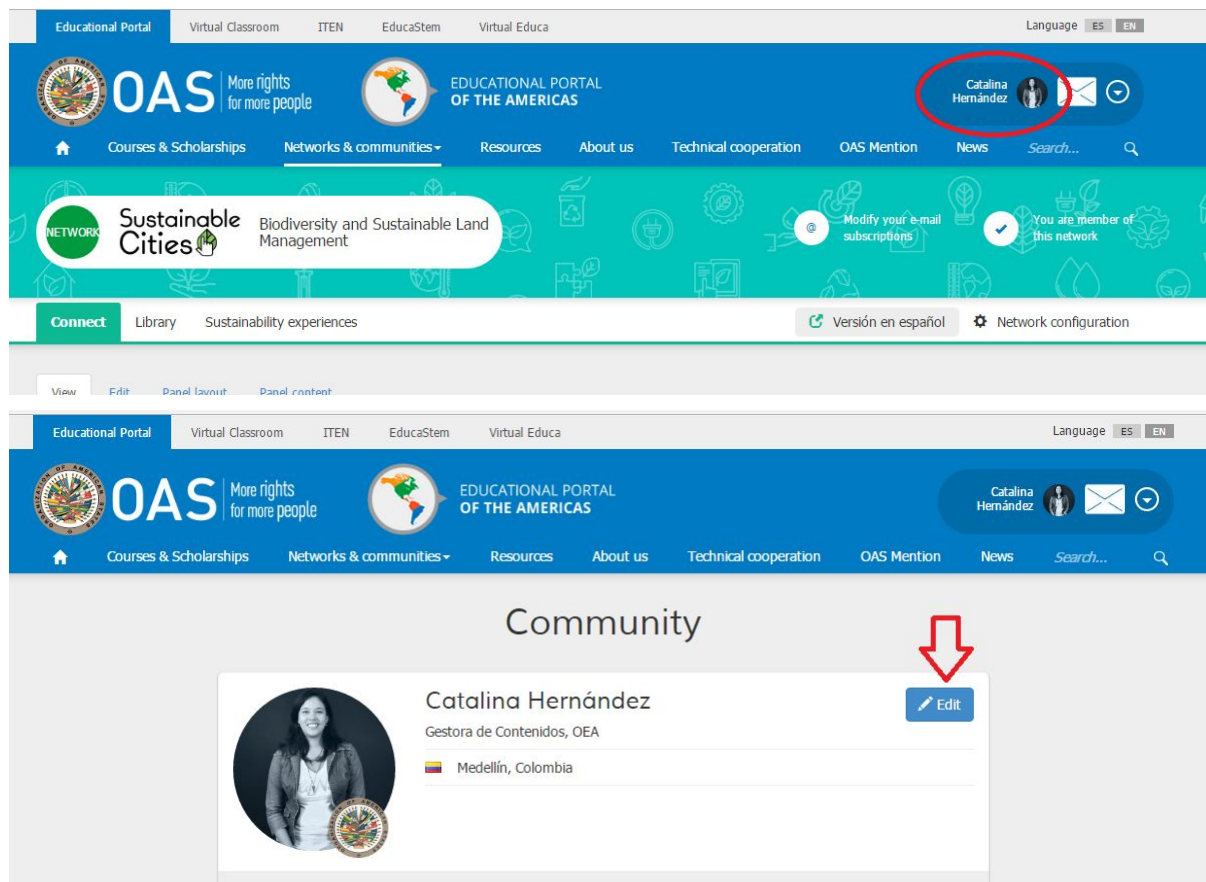
## Step 1: Sign up in the Portal of Education of The Americas [\(Link\)](#)

In the upper right-hand corner you will find an orange button to login (The fastest way is using a Facebook account. OAS won't take any personal information, only your name and profile picture).



## Step 2: Edit or improve your profile

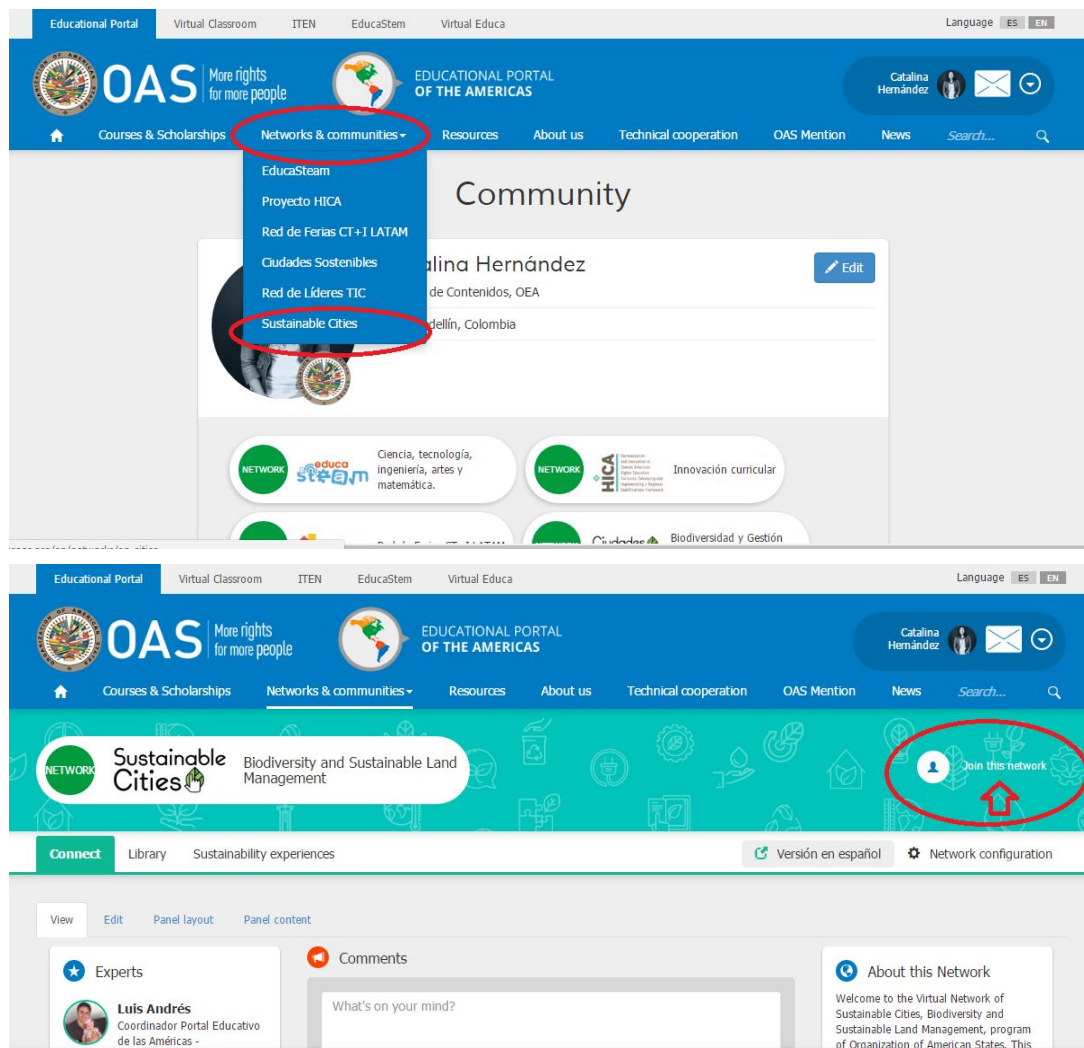
Once you are logged in, click on the photography camp to edit the content of your profile (Picture, professional experience, interest areas).

The admin of the page will allow your access to the network (It could take some minutes).

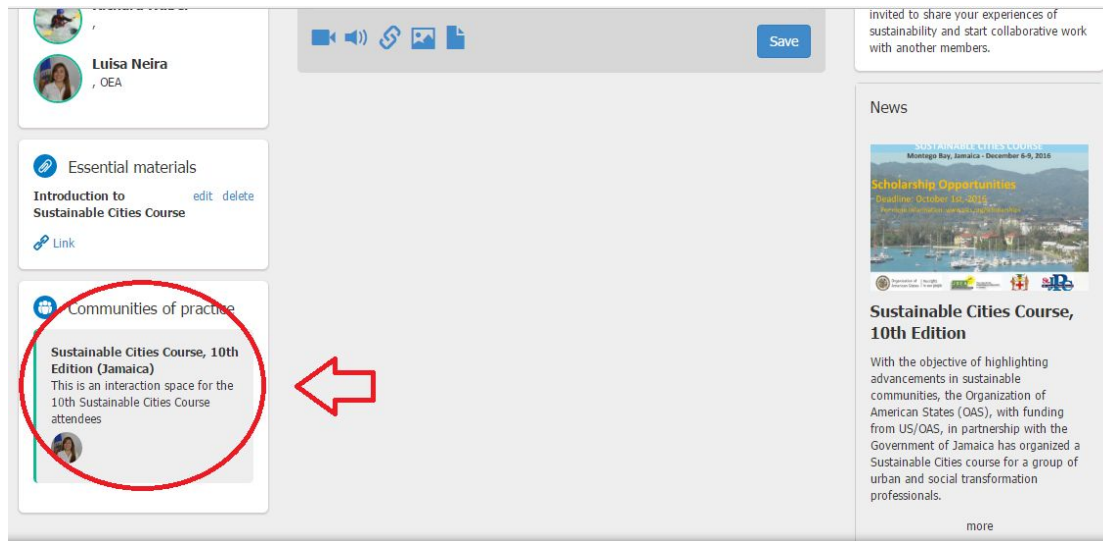


### Step 4: Join the Jamaica’s Course Community

We would like for you to join us in the Jamaica’s Course Community, where we will publish important information and where we expect you to upload your discussion/notes from the breakout groups.

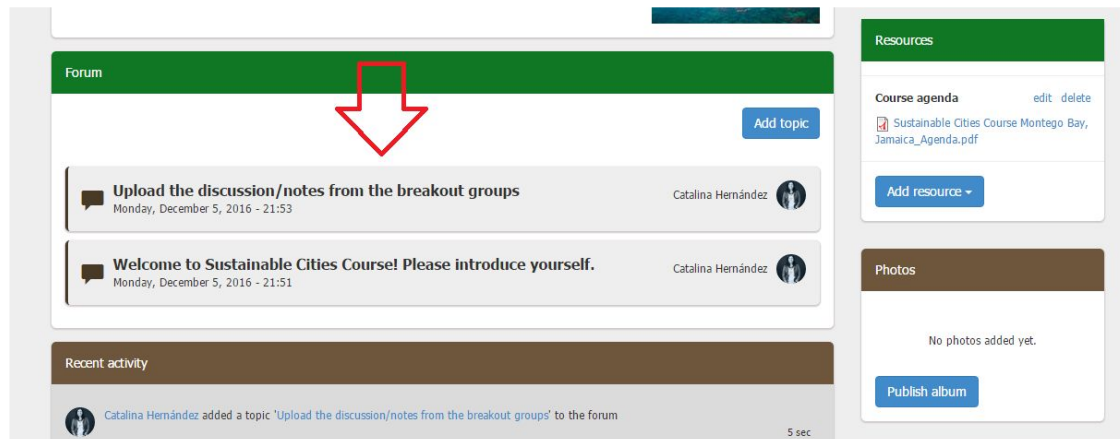
Click on: “Sustainable Cities Course, 10th Edition (Jamaica)” located in the the left-hand column.
